Pediatric Pathology Visiting Scholar Award

Preface: *The Department of Pathology at Children's Hospital of Boston has established a Visiting Scholar Award for anatomic pathology residents, pediatric pathology fellows and pediatric pathologists from other institutions.*

Goals: *To provide for cultural exchange and participation in the pediatric pathology fellowship program, general involvement in departmental learning and diagnostic activities, acquisition of specific clinical or research skills or other defined goals as appropriate, for a period of one month.*

Eligibility: *Applicants must be residents in anatomic pathology with a demonstrated interest in pediatric pathology, pediatric pathology fellows in an accredited program, or pediatric pathologists.*

Stipend: *Lodging will be arranged and funded by the Department. In addition, travel expenses and meals will be reimbursed up to an additional \$2000.00 (travel expenses subject to approval in advance, meals not to exceed Massachusetts CONUS per diem rate and reimbursement of travel and meals requiring paid receipts.)*
