### **Application Instructions**

**General Instructions:** All portions of the form must be completed. Incomplete forms will be not be considered. Although Institutional Review Board (for human studies) or Animal Care Committee (for animal studies) will be required before funding is finally approved, such approval can be deferred until after an initial funding decision has been made.

A complete application includes the following:

1. Cover Sheet (see next page)
2. Brief Description of Proposed Training Experience (limited to 2 pages, excluding references) - type of training, how it will be pursued, how it will promote the applicants career in pediatric pathology.
3. Itemized budget (limit to 1 page).
4. Letter of support from chief or laboratory director at institution that the applicant wants to visit indicating approval of the proposed training experience.
5. Letter of support from the applicant's chief.
